


Setting up Your Profile

When your Hudl profile is created you will receive an email like the one on the right welcoming you to the Hudl team. If you are already on a team your notification will be slightly different. To get started click on the “Get Started” button



Setting up Your Profile

If you are a new user of Hudl you will be prompted to create a new password. It has to be at least 6 characters long and include a number or special character (i.e. official25 or Offic!al). Please note this password.



Accessing the Video Library

Almost all of your time will be spent in your video library. To access the library click on the Video menu item at the top of the screen and then select Library.



Accessing the Video Library


This is what the video library looks like. You will find the 2014-15 Season on the right and a list of weeks for the season.



All games will be placed in the week when they were played. This will help keep the season organized and help you find your games more quickly. For this season you will only have access to the games you worked or games/playlists others have shared with you.


Accessing the Video Library

When the IFOA receives an exchange from a school, the video will be shared with the crew that worked the game. We will only know this if you have entered the game on your schedule on the IFOA site. If a video is shared with you, you will receive an email similar to the one at right. You can either click the link in the email or access the video after logging in.



Accessing the Video Library

Navigate to the game you want to view and check the box next to it. The playlist for the game will appear below the video screen. You can select multiple games, but it is recommended to usually only view one game at a time.



Menus and Controls

After you select a playlist you'll see a list like this below the video. The up/down arrow will allow you to increase/decrease the size of this list in the menu. If teams enter data in the other fields, you will see it listed here. The squiggle line indicates there are call-outs for that particular play. Check the box next to plays to create your own playlists. 100 plays are shown at a time so if you have more than 100 plays use the -> Next and <- Previous buttons to navigate. If there is data in the other fields (i.e. ODK is Offense/Defense/Kick, DN, DIST) you can filter the clips using the Filter Clips control.

To save your own playlists, select the list of plays and click “Save Playlist”. You will be prompted to name your playlist. **If you are going to comment on plays, save them as a separate playlist before sharing with others.**



Menus and Controls

These items control playback.

- A – Replay from start point
- B – Fast/Slow Backward
- C – Play/Pause
- D – Slow/Fast Forward
- E – Time elapsed/Total Time for current play
- F – Expand to full screen
- G – Previous Play
- H – Next Play

To view a play frame by frame, pause the video and select the Slow Backward/Forward. This is a great way to see close plays or track a specific player.



This menu allows for various telestrations. For example, the squiggle line to get arrows, blocks, lines, boxes and free hand. While this is menu item is live, pause the video and add call-outs to your video.




Menus and Controls

The menu button gives you different options for playback. Play each clip only once, loop the current clip or have it roll from one play to another. If the video provides multiple views in each play, you can choose to watch both or just one. If you want to replay the video without notes, click the “Hide All Notes” checkbox. This will help if you want to watch a play through that has several call-outs added to it.

This is a sample of using the arrow to point out a player or situation to call attention. Also note the circle on the timeline indicating a call-out happens. When played the video will run until a call-out is identified.



Menus and Controls

This is an example of the use of a dynamic call-out (dotted circle on menu bar). When creating these call-outs you can modify the size and direction of movement using the controls in the pop out. You can also move the call-out by left-clicking the call-out and dragging your mouse. You can also remove them.

Add text by selecting the text item from the menu bar. This will also create a call-out that will stop the video when reached. You can combine text with other call-outs.




Sharing a Playlist

To share a playlist with someone else on the IFOA team, select the playlist and click the Share button above the game listing. You may do this if you have someone outside your crew work with you or share your comments with your crew. You may also do this to share specific plays with an IFOA trainer to get feedback on a play.

After selecting “Share” the screen at right will appear. Select the individual or group you want to share the video. You can choose to include the notes/call-outs you added to your playlist. You can also add a message they will see in the email notification about your share.

Please do not share with “All Team”
